Club News Board of Director Elections

All members wishing to run for the Board of Directors must have their biography turned into Nick Eatmon by October 12th. Biographies along with ballots will be mailed out 30 days prior to the November annual meeting.

If you're interested in running, below are qualification requirements from the MCCC bylaws.

The Board of Directors shall be elected by ballot of eligible shareholders at the annual meeting in November. The President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary shall be elected by ballot by the Board of Directors amongst their membership.

There shall be elected annually three new members to the Board of Directors who shall be dues paying, preferred stockholding members in good standing and shall serve a term of three years. Eligibility for service on the Board of Directors requires a nominee to be dues paying, preferred stockholding member of the Club in good standing for a minimum of three consecutive years immediately preceding their election. At all times, at least five members of the Board of Directors may, if elected by membership, serve two full consecutive terms on the Board, after which they will not be eligible for reelection until one full year has expired. All members of the Board of Directors shall at all times by be dues paying members of the Morehead City Country Club, Inc. in good standing and who are the registered owners of one or more shares of preferred stock of said club.





Alternate Shot ~ Players will make a decision who will tee off on either the odd or even holes. From the tee shot on players will alternate shots until the ball is holed. Ball to be played down.
