Club News Board of Director Elections

All members wishing to run for the Board of Directors must have their biography turned into Nick Eatmon by October 12th. Biographies along with ballots will be mailed out 30 days prior to the November annual meeting.

If you're interested in running, below are qualification requirements from the MCCC bylaws.

The Board of Directors shall be elected by ballot of eligible shareholders at the annual meeting in November. The President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary shall be elected by ballot by the Board of Directors amongst their membership.

There shall be elected annually three new members to the Board of Directors who shall be dues paying, preferred stockholding members in good standing and shall serve a term of three years. Eligibility for service on the Board of Directors requires a nominee to be dues paying, preferred stockholding member of the Club in good standing for a minimum of three consecutive years immediately preceding their election. At all times, at least five members of the Board of Directors may, if elected by membership, serve two full consecutive terms on the Board, after which they will not be eligible for reelection until one full year has expired. All members of the Board of Directors shall at all times be dues paying members of the Morehead City Country Club, Inc. in good standing and who are the registered owners of one or more shares of preferred stock of said club.

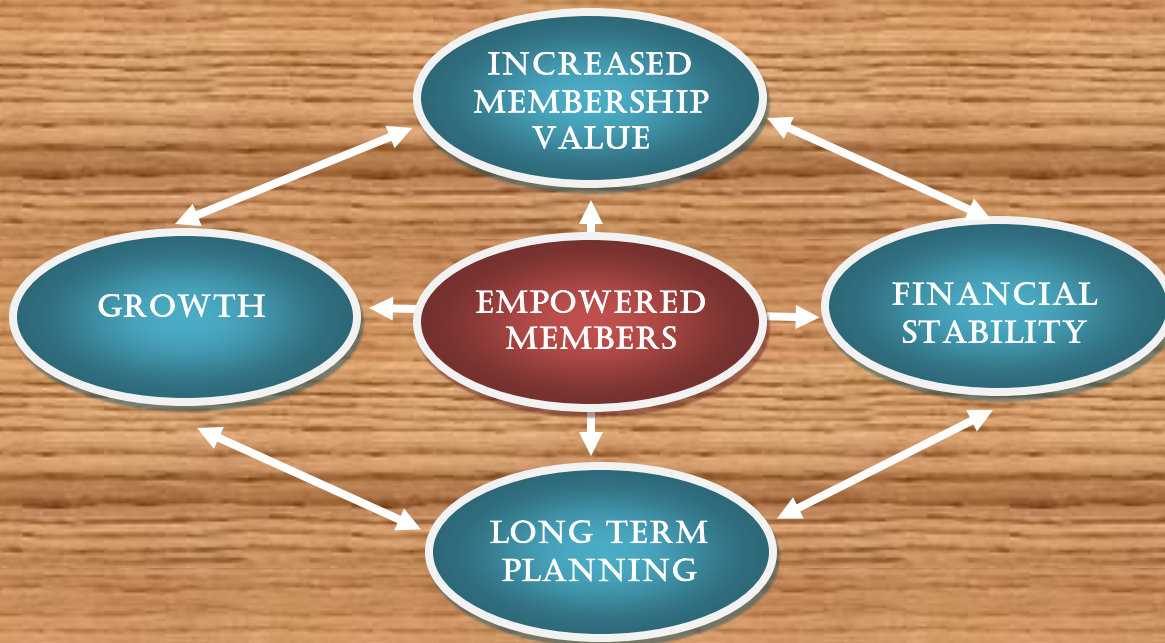

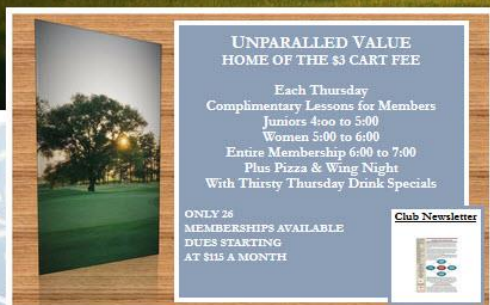
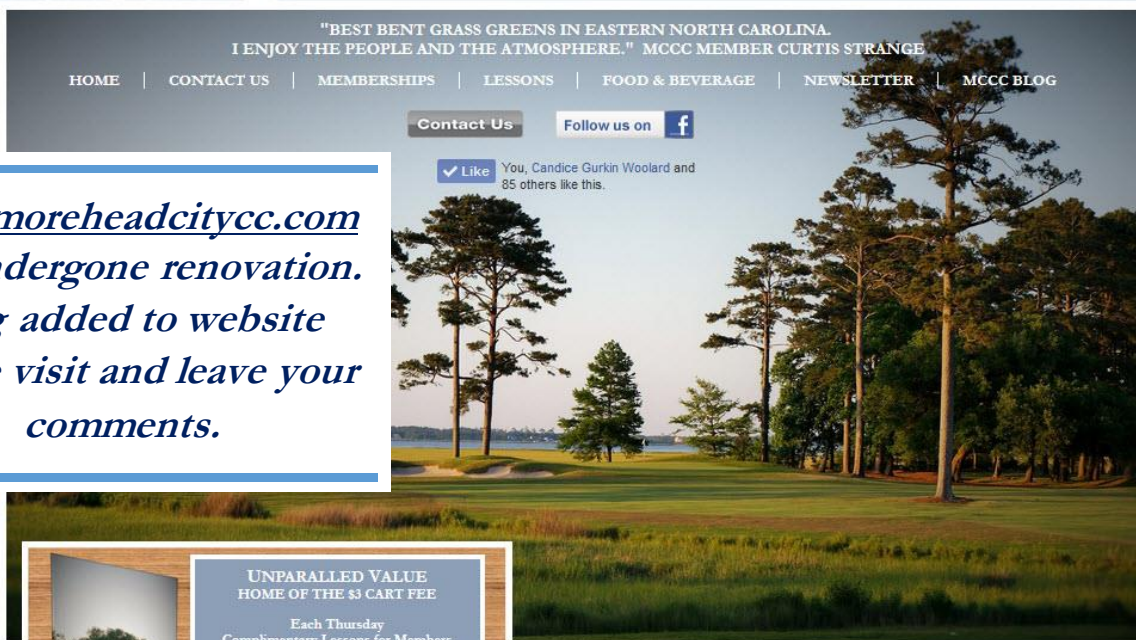

Survey results are vital in club decisions. From past surveys the club has made decisions to improve the bar pool areas. As the club debt is reduced larger projects such as bunker and tee renovation are pushed to the forefront.

Additional comments:

Nearly 100% of all play fell under the 3:45 guideline over the last 3 months. Well over 500 receipts were turned in!

Improved Pace of Play Guidelines ~ 3:45 Minutes. For every non par 3 cart path only hole add 2 minutes to the total time. Our #1 complaint is pace of play. This is a common issue not only at MCCC but throughout the golf industry. Most common complaints come from waiting on fivesomes. The staff is not concerned with fivesomes as long as they are considerate to others and play in the allotted time.

Group rights: As long as groups are within the pace of play guideline and within one hole of the next group they are not required to let players through. Anytime a group falls a hole or more behind they are obligated to dose the gap or let quicker players through.

In the near future each hole monument will have a dock. Playing at the proper pace with a tee time at 12 each tee the dock will show 12. If you fall 5 minutes behind the dock will show 12:05. Any group falling a hole or more behind and falling behind the desired pace is to let groups waiting through. If groups are not allowing players through they will be documented. Those documented on more than one occasion will be subject to suspension.

Pace of Play Suggestions:

-Call your food and drink order in before making the turn. A menu will be placed on the 8th tee.

-Plan your shot while riding to your ball, or while others are playing. Be ready when it is your turn.

-Go directly to your ball; don't follow others unless assisting in a search

-When on paths only, take several clubs with you to your ball.

-Be efficient with pre-shot routine

-Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green towards the next tee

-Unless experienced, play standard tees, not the championship tees. If eligible play the new forward tees.

Pace of Play Rewards: Collect your golf receipt upon checking in. If you play in 3hrs and 45 minutes or less turn your receipt into the golf shop. On the first Friday of each month a name will be drawn with the winner receiving \$100 credit.

Tournament Formats:

- Saturday ~ 1st Nine Best Ball
- Saturday ~ 2nd Nine Texas Scramble
- Sunday ~ 1st Nine Superball
- Sunday ~ 2nd Nine Alternate Shot

Best Ball ~ Each player will receive 100% of their adjusted course handicap. Players will play their own ball on each hole taking the best net score. Ball to be played down.

Texas Scramble ~ Both players tee off. The best tee shot is chosen. Players then play their own ball until the ball is holed with the best score being used. Tee shot can be moved 6 inches no closer to the hole without changing terrain with the exception of the putting green. All other shots are to be played down.

Superball ~ Best shot is used for each shot with each player playing from the chosen ball until the ball is holed. Ball can be moved 6 inches no closer to the hole without changing terrain with the exception of the putting green. One ball rule applies.

Alternate Shot ~ Players will make a decision who will tee off on either the odd or even holes. From the tee shot on players will alternate shots until the ball is holed. Ball to be played down.

Teeing areas: Participants playing gold tees and women playing the red tees will have their course handicap adjusted for the difference in course rating for the 9-Hole Best Ball Net.
